

### Words of Encouragement

November 30, 2025

"For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." (Luke 2:11)

Circle that word "Savior". That's what Christmas is all about.

But why do we need a Savior anyway?
The Bible tells us that we have all sinned:
we have all committed evil acts (Romans
3:10-18). As a result of our sin, we deserve
God's anger and judgment. We were born
on a one-way track to hell.

But, God had "a plan" for you and kome. He sent us a Savior so we could get into heaven. That's the good news: a Savior has been born!

Jesus came to save us. He saves us from sin by forgiving our sins. He saves us from God's righteous punishment by justifying us with His blood. He saves us from death by giving us eternal life. For all these reasons and more, Jesus is rightfully worshiped as the Savior of the world. To the person who trusts in Him, Jesus Christ becomes "Savior".

Question: Is Jesus your "personal" Savior?

Many people view Christianity as attending church, performing rituals, and/or not committing certain sins. That is not Christianity. True Christianity is a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Accepting

Jesus as your personal Savior means placing your own personal faith and trust in Him. No one is saved by the faith of others. No one is forgiven by doing certain deeds. The only way to be saved is to personally accept Jesus as your Savior, trusting in His death as the payment for your sins and His resurrection as your guarantee of eternal life (John 3:16). Is Jesus personally your Savior? The Bible says that Jesus came to seek and to save. He offers you:

- · forgiveness for your past.
- peace of mind in the present.
- · and a secure future in eternity.

These are God's gifts to you!

Two thousand years ago, wise men sought Christ. And "the wise" still seek Christ today. I challenge you to be wise, and to seek the Christ of Christmas.

God says, "Seek and you shall find." It's His promise. He's God's gift to you.






